Application for Partnership for International Education Grant

Terms and conditions of the Grant

The Partnership for International Education Grant is designed to recognize, award, and assist international students who wish to continue their studies on a post-secondary or graduate level. The role of the grant is to aid international students in achieving their desire to obtain a career education on the collegiate level.

1. International students that have a F1 or M1 Visa may apply for this grant. Money received under this grant may be used solely for educational purposes (tuition and fees).
2. The total amount of the International Education Grant is \$2400 for the first academic year for each program level – Associates, Bachelors, and Masters. The \$2400 will be paid over the first 48 credit hours as follows: \$200 per term for a 4 credit hour load, \$400 per term for an 8 credit hour load, \$600 per term for a 12 credit hour load and \$800 per term for a 16 credit hour load.

These funds are applied to tuition and fees while the student is enrolled at National College. Upon recommendation by the Director of International Programs or the Campus Director, and upon approval by the Vice President / Regional Director of Operations, students who have had an interruption in their attendance due to returning to their home country for Visa or health-related issues may still be eligible to receive the remainder of their award.

3. National College will provide up to 100 Partnership for International Education Grants each year. The certification of receipt of the Partnership for International Education Grant application will be based upon the date that it is received by National College's Director of International Programs. The award year for the grant is defined as July 1st to June 30th. The total amount of funds allocated by National College for the scholarship is \$100,000 each award year.
4. National College places this grant in force for applications received after March 7, 2011. The availability of the grant will be evaluated at the end of each calendar year.

Submit the following materials to National College:

- Completed National College International Student application
- \$125 application fee
- The grant form signed and dated by the student
- A letter of sponsorship

Duties of all parties to the Grant

It is required that all parties sign and date this agreement and grant application. The signature of the student and sponsor are required to complete the applications process for the Partnership for International Education Grant.
